Dear Pastor and praying Church,

I hope that this letter finds you all well. We are all doing well and looking forward to completing the road of deputation and getting to the field!

In Galatians 5:13-15 Paul wanted to see grace manifested among the believers; that they would experience the liberty that is found in Christ. The word liberty describes the spirit-filled and fruitful life where the grace of God provides to all that come to Him by faith, Hebrews 6:11. So we see God's call to liberty, verse 13. This call to liberty is a promise to all that have had a new birth experience, Ephesians 2:8-9. Total liberty will only be found in the Lord Jesus Christ. We also see the caution of liberty, verse 13, "only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh." Yes, there are blessings in our liberty in Christ, but it also has boundaries. Paul wanted them to know that they have been set free from the bondage of the law. They were to protect themselves from the appetites of the old nature that longs to take control. Later Paul reminded them of Galatians 5:24. Someone once said, 'Christian freedom is freedom from sin to serve the Lord; it is not freedom to sin and to serve self!' Believer's conduct is to be controlled by the "liberty" in Christ to be the proper light before a lost and dying world. We see lastly the care of liberty, "but by love serve one another." One of the greatest goals for true liberty is that we serve one another in love. The principle for loving one another is taught by the Lord Jesus Christ in His response to a lawyers question in Matthew 22:37, 39-40.

Someone once said, 'Grace is manifested in a liberty that frees us to serve one another "in the spirit of love.'" Let's serve one another that the gospel of Jesus Christ may bring others to Him. **The Ministry:** In our last letter we were going to be in Texas for the month of February. Well, we are still here and enjoying our time here in Texas with a few little detours. One to Mississippi and the other to Oklahoma. We had a great meeting there in Mississippi. We met many of God's precious people, serving Christ. We had great meetings there in Shawnee, OK. We were able to participate in their visitation program.
