Dear Praying Friends,

It's very exciting to finally be able to write an update on the mission field! This is our first official prayer letter from New Zealand. We have been here for roughly 2 months now and cannot begin to express how good it feels to be in the center of God's will here among the Kiwi people.

We are humbled at how God has provided for us through the sacrifices of so many of you. We want to take a moment to specifically thank everyone who took part in giving towards our move both through monthly support and special gifts. Moving around the world has been a pretty hefty and expensive endeavor. We are so thankful that we were able to save funds for as long as we did in preparation for this trip. God has provided everything we have needed up to now in so many different ways.

Since arrival, things have been pretty busy around here. God has given us many opportunities to serve Him. We've begun working with the young people here at the church, taken over the adult Sunday School class, helped with song leading, preaching/teaching, etc. I was recently privileged to be on an ordination council for a young Kiwi preacher on the other side of the South Island. It was encouraging to see a New Zealand man stepping up to answer God's call on his life. Please pray God would call others to the gospel ministry here in New Zealand.

After nearly a month of waiting, our container has finally met us on the other side of the Pacific. It's a real blessing to see a garage full of John & Romans and a home full of our own personal belongings. We are already preparing and designing packets to join together with these J&R booklets. We look forward to distributing them in the coming days. We have begun distributing tracts and gospel material downtown. Pray that God would give us fruit for our labor and that our fruit might remain!

We ask that you would continue to pray with us for God to give us wisdom regarding residency status. We hope to have this settled within a year if possible. This would allow us the freedom to plant a new work here on the island.

Do also pray that God would comfort Amy in these last days of her pregnancy. She is expected to give birth in just a few short weeks, April 26th. We are working hard to have everything complete and ready for when the baby arrives. Pray the birth goes well and that there are no complications. We look forward to adding this new little addition to our family.
